The best score of two attempts in each event are totaled for the overall score.

New this year is each local champion per age/gender division will advance directly to the State Finals. State will be held on Saturday, October 16 in the Bergstrom Football Indoor Practice Facility on the campus of Iowa State University in Ames, Iowa.
