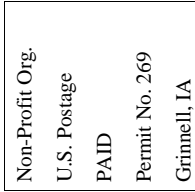

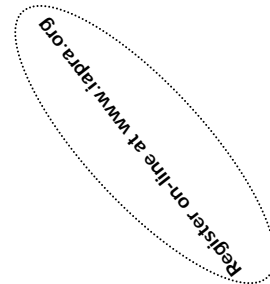

COURSE CONTENT

GOALS

The National Swimming Pool Foundation developed the Certified Pool Operators course to educate personnel in the field of aquatics in the most up-to-date techniques available. COURSE CONTENT

Successful completion of at least 75% on a written open book exam will result in certification as a Certified Pool Operator (CPO) issued by the National Swimming Pool Foundation (NSPF) valid for five years.

STATE APPROVED

This course is approved by the Iowa Department of Public Health. It meets all requirements specified by the IDPH Code Regulation 15.11 (1) and IPRA approved for 1.3 CEU's. In addition, all Certified Pool Operators must receive an average of 10 hours of approved CEU's in a five year period concurrent with his/her CPO certification. These continuing education hours may be obtained by taking the IPRA CEU Aquatic Workshops.

CERTIFICATION

A CPO certification is valid for five years from the date noted at the bottom of the certificate.

Full Course - the student will attend all sessions and take the *open book certification test*. Class times are 8:30 AM—5:00 PM on both days. *Cost \$210.00 Non-IPRA Member or \$195.00 IPRA Member/per person* and includes lecture, all hand-outs, lunches, breaks and state registration fee.

NEW - Fusion Course - NSPF is offering an online course which replaces day one of the full course. Successful candidate receive a Record of Completion. To participate in full course day two, candidate must bring the completion certificate with them.

CPO Manual - *\$45.00 per manual*. **This a newly revised manual with a 2011 copyright**. Manuals are sold separately and not included with the full course registration fee.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Class size limited. Registrations will be taken on a first-come-first-filled basis.

CPO Manual will be mailed in advance whenever possible. Registrations received later than two weeks before each course will not have materials mailed. Rather, participants will receive materials on-site.

Participants are responsible for obtaining his/her own lodging. If you are staying at the property, please identify yourself as with the "CPO School".

IPRA reserves the right to cancel or alter the date of a school due to weather conditions, low enrollment or illness of an instructor. Should this occur, every effort will be made to relocate you to the next convenient school.

A full refund will only be given when notice of cancellation is received at least two weeks prior to the scheduled school. After this timeframe, a prorated refund may be offered. To receive a possible refund, participants must contact the IPRA office in writing.
